Keep fingers clear of the gaps between the cover, and the locking ring.



Installation Instructions

Before installation, ensure the former and waste are correctly supported from below and check the wet floor area slopes correctly towards the waste and the waste pipe is laid in the shortest distance to the pump.


Push the deburred end of a Polypipe*, plastic equivalent or suitably protected copper pipe (not supplied), firmly into position following all the normal JG Speedfit assembly precautions and instructions;

Fit the JG adaptor locking ring "2" (supplied);

Position the PGTF and Tuff Form into the required location with the waste drain pipe suitably routed.

Apply sealant to the underside of outer rim and install into the centre hole of the Tuff Form Former. Use 4 CSK Head screws (3) to secure the PGTF in place. Ensure the screw heads are flush and do not protrude or they may damage the wet floor covering.

This sequence can be changed to suit your installation requirements.



Install the wet-floor covering ensuring all of the manufacturer's instructions are followed. Trim the wet-floor covering to fit the PGTF opening and align and fit the clamp ring (5) with qty 4 M6 stainless steel screws (6).

Position the grid cover (9) over the assembly, align the arrows and rotate the cover clockwise until the lugs snap into place.

For added security remove the two screw knock-outs and fasten the cover using the Qty 2 M4 stainless steel screws (12).

User Care Instructions

This PGTF waste is designed for low maintenance and reliable operation.

The Pumped waste should be checked as part of a planned maintenance programme and any parts showing evidence of damage or misuse must be replaced.

Keeping your pump waste clean

This product should be cleaned periodically to remove any accumulation of hair or other waste material, using normal domestic bathroom cleaning materials.

Clean these parts using warm soapy water. Also flush and wash down the inner body of the trap in the floor using warm soapy water or normal domestic bathroom cleaning materials.

To clean, First remove the top cover by removing the two M4 screws (if fitted), rotate the cover anti-clockwise and lift off.

If necessary the waste can now be rodded to clear any blockage or waste material. Reinstall following the above instructions.

Disinfecting

Where disinfecting is necessary, standard established procedures for disinfecting equipment should be used taking due care and attention to the warnings below concerning possible effects of aggressive chemicals on plastics.

After cleaning always flush down with water then wipe thoroughly with a damp cloth to remove any cleaning material residues before drying off.

Do not use strong or concentrated acidic or alkaline cleaning materials as these may discolour or otherwise damage the product.

AKW do not approve or recommend autoclave cleaning of any of the components due to the damage this can cause to the special engineering plastics used in the construction of this product.

Packaging

This waste is supplied in a plastic bag to keep the product unsolled until installation; it may also be packed in a cardboard box. Both are suitable for recycling operations and should be disposed of in accordance with local recycling regulations.
